1963 AFL EASTERN DIVISION PLAYOFF GAME BOSTON 26, BUFFALO 8

December 28, 1963, at Buffalo. Attendance 33,044 Boston fullback Larry Garron turned two short passes from Babe Parilli into touchdowns, and Gino Cappelletti kicked four field goals, as Boston won 26-8 to become the first Eastern Division team other than Houston to reach the AFL Championship Game.

Cappelletti connected from 28 yards out on the Patriots' second drive. On their next possession, Parilli dumped a pass in the flat to Garron, who broke two tackles and sprinted away for a 59-yard scoring play. Two more field goals put the Patriots ahead 16-0 at the half.

The Bills changed quarterbacks in the third quarter, and Daryle Lamonica, as was his wont, went deep, finding Elbert Dubenion for a 93-yard scoring play.

In the fourth quarter, the Patriots eliminated any Buffalo hopes for a comeback. After driving to the Buffalo 17, Parilli again went to the flat to Garron, who again raced in for a score.

1963 AFL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME SAN DIEGO 51, BOSTON 10

January 5, 1964, at San Diego. Attendance 30,127

Fullback Keith Lincoln had one of the greatest days in the history of the playoffs to lead San Diego to a smashing 51-10 victory against Boston. Lincoln gained 206 yards on 13 carries, caught seven passes for 123 yards, and even found time to complete his only pass for 20 yards.

Lincoln got the Chargers off to a quick start. On the second play from scrimmage, he raced straight up the middle of a 56-yard gain. Seven plays later, Tobin Rote scored on a quarterback sneak. The next time Lincoln touched the ball, he rambled 67 yards for a score. And then, after the Patriots cut the margin to 14-7, Lincoln's backfield mate, halfback Paul Lowe, reeled off another long run, going 58 yards for the Chargers' third score of the first quarter.

The Chargers' continued to flex their offensive muscles, as a short field goal and a 14-yard touchdown pass from Rote to Don Norton built the halftime lead to 31-10. In the second half, Rote found Lance Alworth with a 48-yard scoring pass, backup quarterback John Hadl connected with Lincoln on a 25-yard touchdown pass, and Hadl scored on a keeper, all contributing to a record 610 yards total offense.
