1967 AFL CHAMPIONSHIP GAME OAKLAND 40, HOUSTON 7

Big plays in the seconds on either side of halftime turned a tough game into a rout, as the Raiders won their first AFL title with a 40-7 victory against Houston.

The Raiders led 10-0 in the final minute of the half, the big play having been a 69-yard touchdown run by Hewritt Dixon, who had been converted to fullback after three years at tight end with Denver. The Raiders lined up for a field goal attempt from the Houston 17, but, instead, quarterback Daryle Lamonica took the snap and threw to a wide open Dave Kocourek for a touchdown with 18 seconds remaining to build the lead to 17-0.

The Oilers hoped for a big play to open the second half, and they got it, but it was in favor of the Raiders. Zeke Moore fumbled the kickoff and Oakland recovered deep in Houston territory, leading to Lamonica's one-yard quarterback sneak. In the next two quarters, George Blanda kicked three field goals, to give him 16 points for the day, and Lamonica threw a touchdown pass to Bill Miller, as Oakland cruised into its first Super Bowl.
